Aron Demetz, geboren 1972 in Sterling, Südtirol.

„Ein Baum steht mit seinen Wurzeln statisch, immer an der gleichen Stelle. Deswegen sind meine Figuren auch relativ statisch, nicht bewegt. Weil sie aus dem Baumstamm entstehen, haben meine Skulpturen auch nur eine bestimmte Größe. Aber deswegen haben sie auch diese senkrechte Stellung. Keine Bewegung.“

Das figurativ-naturalistische Werk des Künstlers Aron Demetz (geboren 1972 in Sterling, Südtirol) besteht fast ausschließlich aus Arbeiten in verschiedenen Holzarten und wird nur durch wenige Bronzeplastiken und Arbeiten in Marmor oder Glas ergänzt.

Aus Zedern-, Ahorn- oder Nussbaumstämmen fertigt er grob maschinell gesägte Grundformen - oft wird der unterste Teil des Stammes als Basis für die lebensgroße Skulptur verwendet. Nach dieser Vorarbeit schnitzt Demetz mit Hammer und Meißel die endgültige Form aus dem Holz.

Sollen solche Arbeitsspuren nicht sichtbar bleiben, wird die Oberfläche schließlich mit Raspeln und Schleifpapier verfeinert. Mit dieser "Haut" seiner meist nackten Figuren beginnt für ihn die eigentliche Arbeit: Mal wird sie mit in den Bergen gesammeltem Fichtenharz getränkt (wie bei Uomo | Donna 2007), bis zur Unkenntlichkeit verschmiert (wie bei zahlreichen senza titolo-Arbeiten, die in den Folgejahren entstanden) oder gar durch Feuer verkohlt (wie bei Cinder Ella 2011 oder den Burning Man-Versionen bis 2013, von denen er Bronzeabgüsse herstellte).

Demetz lernte ab 1986 an der Kunstschule in Wolkenstein in Gröden Holzbildhauerei und besuchte anschließend bis 1993 die dortige Landesberufsschule für Holzbildhauer, Holzschnitzer und Fassmaler. In den Jahren 1997/98 ergänzte er diese Ausbildung durch ein Studium der Bildhauerei bei Christian Höpfner an der Akademie der Bildenden Künste in Nürnberg.

Seitdem hatte Demetz eine Reihe von internationalen und musealen Gruppen- und Einzelausstellungen in Europa, Asien und den USA. Im Januar 2010 wurde er für drei Jahre als Professor für Bildhauerei an die Accademia di Belle Arti in Carrara berufen. Weiterhin vertreten auf der Biennale von Venedig stellte er zur 53. sein Holzfiguren-Ensemble Untitled im italienischen Pavillon aus. Zur 59. Biennale von Venedig wurde er ebenfalls eingeladen, seine Werke zu präsentieren, dieses Mal im nationalen Pavillon der Elfenbeinküste.

“A tree is static with its roots, always in the same place. That's why my figures are relatively static, not moving. Because they emerge from the tree trunk, my sculptures are only a certain size. But that's also why they have this vertical position. No movement.”

Aron Demetz's (born 1972 in Sterling, Südtirol) figurative-naturalist oeuvre consists almost exclusively of works in various types of wood, complemented by a few bronze sculptures and works in marble or glass.

From cedar, maple or walnut tree trunks, he makes roughly machine-sawn basic forms - often using the lowest part of the trunk as the base for the life-size sculpture. After this preliminary work, Demetz uses a hammer and chisel to carve her final form from the wood.

If such traces of work are not to remain visible, the surface is finally refined with rasps and sandpaper. It is with this "skin" of his mostly naked figures that the real work begins for him: sometimes it is soaked with spruce resin collected in the mountains (as in Uomo | Donna 2007), smeared beyond recognition (as in numerous senza titolo works created in subsequent years), or even charred by fire (as in Cinder Ella 2011 or the Burning Man versions until 2013, of which he made bronze casts).

Aron Demetz (1972, born in Sterling, South Tyrol) studied wood sculpture at the art school in Selva in Val Gardena from 1986 and then attended the local regional vocational school for wood sculptors, wood carvers and barrel painters until 1993. In 1997/98 he completed this training by studying sculpture with Christian Höpfner at the Academy of Fine Arts in Nuremberg.

Since then Demetz has had a number of international and museum-based group and solo exhibitions in Europe, Asia and the USA. In January 2010, he was appointed Professor of Sculpture at the Accademia di Belle Arti in Carrara for three years. At the 53rd Venice Biennale, his wooden figure ensemble Untitled was exhibited in the Italian Pavilion. At the 59th Venice Biennale, the artist again was invited to exhibit his works, this time in the national pavilion of Ivory Coast.
